Looking forward and planning ahead to the upcoming new school year, we encourage parents to enroll their children at their earliest convenience for the teachers and the staff to plan accordingly.

The Saint Andrew Hellenic Afternoon School (HAS) offers a unique educational program that emphasizes not only the Greek language, but also our Greek history, culture, and the Greek Orthodox religion. In expanding and experiencing these concepts and ideas, the students participate in various schoolwide cultural and religious day presentations and events during the school year, which showcases students' language skills and the ability to engage with the Hellenic culture historical days. The OXI Day, the Three Hierarchs, the Christmas pageant, and the 25th of March commemoration are such events the students work hard and proudly perform. Our professional, qualified, and dedicated teachers have many years of experience, and look forward to engaging and teaching your children.

As the Greek school seeks to instill in our students an understanding of the important contribution Greece has made to our western civilization, to our democratic principles, and to the English language. With this understanding of their ethnic background, the Greek School program leads our children to one of the greatest pieces of knowledge, to "Know Thyself". It is our goal that our children appreciate and understand their Greek language and heritage.

For the future, in the event we experience another pandemic, we will continue to comply with the CDC and the Randolph Department of Health protocols to ensure a safe and comfortable school environment for our student's staff and families. Hybrid learning has been challenging for both students and teachers last year therefore, the HAS school year will be all in-person. There will be **no** virtual classes available to students who must stay home. Their teacher will provide assignments on google classroom and the students may utilize the Γεια Χαρα! e-book for support. We look forward to providing your child with an effective and rigorous Greek School education and Greek School Dance program.

- **Arrival and Dismissal:** Please enter at the office entrance to drop off and pick up your child. It is imperative students arrive at school on schedule, parents pick -up their child promptly, and teachers are notified ahead of time for late arrival and early dismissal.
- **Teacher Welcome Letter:** All teachers will send a Welcome Letter to each family. Please make sure to be prepared for class and provide your child with the materials their teacher require. There will be no food and toys permitted and students should bring a water bottle tightly sealed. Additionally, please provide an extra mask for your child in a plastic zip-lock bag.

- **HAS books:** Please bring back all student's Greek books from the previous school year. We will use these books for review in the classroom. For the level 4 to level 6 classes, this includes the geography book and the history book. If the students do not have the geography book or the history book, there will be an additional charge. Please email the administration to place the book order.

- **Assessments:** To meet all student individual needs in learning the Greek language and culture, we must assess students every four weeks in the classroom. All assessments are short and can be found for home practice in the Γεια Χαρά! e-book. This is a new and required process to modify our curriculum and improve our student's performance. You will find in this email the attachments for each assessment for each level. Your child's teacher will update you ahead of time via Google Classroom and/or parent e-mail for what levels and units your child will be assessed.

- **All educational platforms- Google Classroom/Greek123 (Γεια Χαρά!) and Staellinika:** We will continue to use Google Classroom. **There will be an email invitation sent out this week to your child's HAS email. Please look for this email and accept the invitation to Google classroom.** This will be a way to communicate with your child's teacher and you will see all assignments posted accordingly. For private communication, please e-mail your child's teacher using your e-mail. Additionally, we will use the Greek123 platform for access to the student's e-book for homework and review support. The Staellinika is an optional learning platform for watching videos and for students who want a challenge while reviewing mini-lessons. We encourage all students to take advantage all the educational platforms offered.

- The students will need to log in with their student email to retrieve the electronic book (e-book) for homework support.

- The students will need to log in with their student email and click on their recommended level. The recommended level is located with the student's name in the PDF attachment under "Staellinika Course". This is an optional educational resource that is recommended and will spark student interest. Teachers may use this platform for some educational activities.

- Please bookmark this link for student's easy access. The **password** for Staellinika is **sta123**. You may change the password once your child logs in with their student email.

- *****All educational platforms (Google Classroom, Greek123, and Staellinika) will need the student's email to log in. Please write down and save the student email and password on any preferred electronic device. For new students without a student email, please check the parent email to activate the google account and then accept the teacher's invitation to enter Google Classroom.**
